#### **Family Promise with Windborne UMC:**

NRPC has been invited to help families who are experiencing homelessness by supporting Windborne United Methodist Church's host week, June 4 – June 10 with Family Promise (formerly Wake Interfaith Hospitality Network, WIHN). Currently 37 Wake County churches, and 21 support churches, provide emergency shelter to homeless families by providing dinner, hospitality, overnight accommodations and breakfast. Six families will be staying at Windborne UMC, at the corner of Six Forks Rd and Baileywick Rd, and most of them are transported via a van from the Family Promise Day Center on Method Rd (near NC State). 1. Be a van driver

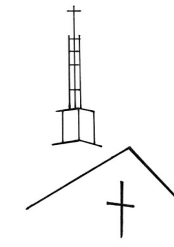
