CONVERSATION CHALLENGE

DEVOTIONS

GATHERING

Light a candle to help you focus this time as sacred.

BEDTIME PRAYER

Be present, merciful God, and protect us through the silent hours of this night, so that we who are wearied by the changes and chances of this fleeting world may rest in your eternal changelessness; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

PROCLAIMING

Read aloud the assigned Daily Bible Reading from the front.

RESPONDING

CARING CONVERSATION

Highs & Lows: Name one thing that went well today. Name one thing that did not go well today.

Thinking About The Week's Theme: Spend some time each night discussing Sacraments. What is a Sacrament? What are the two Sacraments Presbyterians recognize? How do you think God is active in the Lord's Supper or Baptism? Share the story of your child's baptism with them. What about your own baptism story?

Getting Ready for Tomorrow: Name one thing you are concerned about and for which you want prayer. Name one thing that excites you. Pray for one another!

SENDING

Extinguish the candle as a sign of the end of the devotion time.
